2010-2011 BC Snowboard Provincial Series Overall Points Calculation Policy

Approved by the Board of Directors on September 6, 2010

1. Introduction

The 2010-2011 BC Snowboard Provincial Series calendar consists of Snowboard Cross (SBX), Slopestyle (SBS) and HalfPipe (HP) events. The BC Snowboard Provincial Series calendar can be viewed at www.bcsnowboard.com (changes to the calendar may occur throughout the season).

There are the following groups, with a male/female division within the BC Snowboard Provincial Series for 2010-2011:

FIS (no age division) – used as qualification for Canada~Snowboard Nationals
and
Non-FIS: 14 & under
 15 to 18
 19 & over
 Overall (SBS and HP)

2. Eligibility

To be eligible to participate in the 2010-2011 BC Snowboard Provincial Series, an athlete must hold a current BC Snowboard Association (“BCSA”) Advanced Competitor License, or a reciprocal provincial or international association license or membership, and be in good standing.

To be eligible to earn FIS points (www.fis-ski.com) an athlete must hold a current and valid FIS license.

An athlete can participate in more than one discipline.

Note: BCSA Advanced Competitor License and FIS license can be purchased online at www.canadasnowboard.ca.

3. Assignment of Points

Points are assigned to the result in each group in each discipline by gender and group, using the 50 point scale from the FIS points rule book, as follows (the “Assigned Points”):

Assigned Points are assigned to the result at Provincial Finals in each discipline by gender and group, using the 70 point scale from the FIS points rule book, as follows:

4. Results and Ranking

An athlete’s overall series points are the average of his/her best two (2) Assigned Points in one discipline (by discipline and gender) (“Overall Series Points”).

Overall Series Points are then ranked by the highest score by gender and group per discipline (“Overall Series Results”).

Overall Series Results for different disciplines are not added together and are maintained separately for each discipline.

5. Tie Breaking

In the event of a tie, the single highest Assigned Points score will be used to break the tie.

6. Posting of Results

The Overall Series Results list will be published and updated at www.bcsnowboard.com and distributed by email.

7. FIS Overall Series Results Used for Qualification

The results of BC athletes who compete in the FIS group of the BC Snowboard Provincial Series will be used as one of the criteria for qualification to compete in the Canada~Snowboard Nationals (see 2011 Canada~Snowboard Nationals – BC Athletes Selection Policy).

Only BC athletes competing in FIS category will be able to qualify for Nationals.
