The **BC Snowboard Provincial Series** is sanctioned by Canada~Snowboard, FIS and TTR. The events provide opportunity for athletes to compete for FIS and TTR points - and to qualify for Canada~Snowboard Nationals through their points and Provincial Series ranking. These events are the developmental program for young riders, as well as a tool for more established riders to gain FIS and TTR points.

19 and over (sort from Overall Results for SS recognition/Open Age Group SBX)

Overall results will be assigned TTR points. FIS competitors will receive the earned FIS points.

The organizers reserve the right to combined age groups (by gender) if there are less than 4 athletes in an age group by moving that group up to the higher age group.

Draw prizes are provided at awards by random drawing from the participant names for the day (must be present to receive prize).
