BC Snowboard Association is committed to providing a competition series that provides amateur snowboarders with an opportunity to gain competitive experience within a positive and structured series. **Mount Seymour** is committed to supporting amateur sport and is proud to host the **BC Snowboard Provincial Series** Slopestyle events.

The **BC Snowboard Provincial Series** is sanctioned by the Canada~Snowboard and provides opportunity for athletes to compete for FIS and TTR points and to qualify for Canada~Snowboard Nationals. These events are the developmental program for young riders, as well as a tool for more established riders to gain FIS and TTR points.

The Resort

Mt Seymour is pure Canadian West Coast. Located just 30 minutes from downtown Vancouver, Mt Seymour is situated on the east side of Vancouver’s North Shore in the Mt Seymour Provincial Park. The ski area’s 80 hectares of terrain, which includes 40 hectares lit for night skiing, features gentle slopes where beginners will progress rapidly and excel. Advanced skiers and snowboarders will discover challenges and hidden secrets within the area’s naturally contoured slopes, gullies, tree runs, and terrain parks. Freestyle progression continues at Mt Seymour with the development of four terrain parks: Northlands, Young Guns, The Pit, and Mushroom Park.

Overall results will be assigned TTR points. FIS competitors will receive the earned FIS points.

The organizers reserve the right to combined age groups (by gender) if there are less than 4 athletes in an age group by moving that group up to the higher age group.

Rules and Sanction

Competitions are run in accordance with FIS rules. Detailed rules are available at www.fis-ski.com.

Certified helmets are mandatory for all training and competitions.

The competitions are sanctioned by Canada Snowboard, FIS, TTR and BC Snowboard Association.
