BC Snowboard Association is committed to providing a competition series that provides amateur snowboarders with an opportunity to gain competitive experience within a positive and structured series. **Red Resort** is committed to supporting amateur sport and is proud to host the BC Snowboard Provincial Series Snowboard Cross events.

The **BC Snowboard Provincial Series** is sanctioned by Canada~Snowboard and FIS. These events provide opportunity for athletes to compete for FIS points and to qualify for Canada~Snowboard Nationals through their points and Provincial Series ranking, as well as Western SBX Series points. These events are the developmental program for young riders to get started in the SBX pathway.

The Resort

Red Mountain Resort has been named one of the Top Ten Resorts of North America by Forbes Magazine, and is quickly becoming one of North America's most sought-after mountain destinations.

Red is only a ten minutes drive north of the Canada/US Border, a 2.5 hour drive from Spokane International Airport (Washington state) and 3.5 hour drive from Kelowna International Airport. Red is easily accessible from major airports from both Canada and the United States. The regional airports of Trail – a 20 minute drive, and Castlegar – a 30 minute drive also serve the mountain.

At Red, visitors can choose from 88 runs spread across two stellar mountains that feature everything from wide-open groomers to steep, powder-filled glades. With more than 1,685 skiable acres and 880 meters (2,919 feet) of vertical terrain serviced by 6 total lifts, there is a lot to explore at Red. The abundant snow, friendly staff and locals, and the short lift lines are just a few reasons why guests fall in love with Red.

Ski Canada has once again placed Red Mountain Resort's trees, steeps and powder amongst the best in Canada. Along with this, Red's Silverlode and Paradise areas offer plenty of wide-open groomed runs for beginner and intermediate skiers and snowboarders.

All competitors MUST hold a current BC Snowboard Advanced Competitor License (or reciprocal Provincial membership). All FIS competitors MUST hold a current FIS license. Limited Event Membership for each day is available at \$20/day (can be Purchased Onsite). Memberships and licenses can be purchased online at: www.canadasnowboard.ca under Member Services -Memberships and Licenses, SAIP and FIS.

Waivers

All competitors MUST sign an Event Waiver at registration prior to participating in event.
All participants under 19 years of age MUST have a parent or legal guardian sign waiver at event.

Insurance

Each competitor MUST have his or her own medical coverage and insurance.

FIS competitors will receive the earned FIS points

All competitors will receive Overall Provincial Series and Western SBX Series points
