The **BC Snowboard Provincial Series** is sanctioned by the Canada~Snowboard and provides opportunity for athletes to compete for FIS and TTR points and to qualify for Canada~Snowboard Nationals. These events are the developmental program for young riders, as well as a tool for more established riders to gain FIS and TTR points.

The Resort

Sun Peaks is centrally located in the British Columbia Interior and only a 45 minute drive from Kamloops.
