ELIGIBILITY

Competitors must meet the following age limit in order to compete:
Snowboardcross 15 years+ (born before December 31, 1998)

Competitors must also hold a valid FIS License. Canadian athletes can purchase FIS license, SAIP insurance and Provincial Membership before registering at www.canadasnowboard.ca.

\$75.00 per competition (pre-registration) until Wednesday February 19th at 9pm
\$90.00 per competition (on site) registration close: Thursday, February 20th at 4pm

Discounted lift tickets are available for competitors. You will receive a discount voucher at registration. Lift tickets are purchased with voucher at Guest Services in the Village Center Mall.
Training Day and Competition Day Price: 50% discount off regular prices.
