COACH REGISTRATION

For this year's National Championships (all disciplines), coaches must register themselves online for the event. The process literally takes seconds so please make sure this is done prior to your Travel! http://www.canadasnowboard.ca/en/events/calendar/.

Why do I have to register as a coach? Only coaches who have registered will receive coach lift passes and course access at the National Championships. The registration allows us to check that you, as a coach, are licensed and meet the minimum coaching certification requirement for the event you are attending. TEAM INFORMATION AND REGISTRATION

ENTRIES

All athlete entries are due through the provinces by March 21st. The entry form and quota can be found in the attached document. All riders must submit payment to confirm their spot at Nationals no later than **March 28th**. **Spots not paid for by March 28th will be released.**

REGISTRATION FEES and PAYMENT

Spots in the competitions are allocated according to Provincial and Territorial quotas. All entries must come from the PTSA's, but registered athletes can pay for their own registration on-line.

Registration fees are as follows (includes Final/Welcome Party):

U14 Snowboard Cross (13-14 yr old)	\$100
Para Snowboard	\$100
Jr Snowboard Cross (15-19 yr old)	\$100
Sr Snowboard Cross (15+ yr old)	\$100
Both Jr and Sr Snowboard Cross	\$150

Canadian Athletes: U14 Nationals requires a current Provincial Membership

Para Nationals requires a current Provincial Membership

Junior Nationals require current Provincial Membership, SAIP Insurance and FIS License Senior Nationals quire current Provincial Membership, SAIP Insurance and FIS License

International Athletes: Register as an International Competitor. The Event Organizer requires the FIS Entry Form from your National Snowboard Association prior to your arrival at the event. The FIS Entry Form should be email to: admin@bcsnowboard.com.

On-Line Registration for this event closes on March 28th at 11:59pm EST. There will not be any on-site registration for this event.

HPP and Development Canadian Athletes: A certain number of starting spots are allocated for Canadian High Performance Program and Development Team Athletes. Contact aimee@canadasnowboard.ca to confirm registration and payment arrangements.

The age of an athlete is based on his/her age on December 31st. For example, if 'Athlete X' turns 15 years old on January 3rd he must still compete in the U14 category since on December 31st he was 14.

QUOTAS

Each province and territory has an allocated quota of athlete spots for each discipline. Athletes can only qualify through their Provincial or Territorial Associations. Please talk to your PTSA to learn more.

TEAM CAPTAINS' MEETINGS

Each PTSA must provide at least one Team Captain to represent their team of athletes at the Event and at the Team Captains Meetings held each day as shown in the Overall Schedule.

It is up to each team to ensure that the appropriate officials attend the meetings each evening.

One part of the Team Captain's role is to ensure that all of their athletes are on the Registration List. The Team Captain is also required to pick up their athletes' bibs after the bib draw and check the bib numbers for accuracy before leaving the meeting.

TRAINING TIMES











Training times have been created to give athletes the opportunity for additional on-snow training. The Snowboard Cross competition venues will be prepared for athletes use. See Overall Event Schedule for times.

SANCTION

Canada Snowboard and FIS sanction the Sport Chek Canadian Snowboard Cross Championships 2014. For the FIS points scale, the competitions are categorized as:

Senior Snowboard Cross - NorAm Cup Finals

Junior Snowboard Cross - FIS Junior Nationals

RULES

Certified helmets are mandatory for all training and competitions (see FIS Rule 2010.6). The Sport Chek Canadian Snowboard Cross Championships 2014 are organized and run in accordance with FIS Rules.

ANTI-DOPING

Canada Snowboard enforces the guidelines set by the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) in accordance with FIS regulations. If doping control occurs at this event, it will only concern Canadian Snowboard Cross athletes competing in the Senior Nationals.
