Officials and Judging Course

The Level 1 Canada Snowboard Officials course will provide future snowboard officials with a greater understanding of the role they will assume during a competition and to introduce them to the rules of snowboard competition. The training course and on hill training will benefit anyone planning to assume a role of an official at the 2015 Canada Winter Games.

The Introduction to Judging Clinic will provide future snowboard judges with an understanding of the role they will assume at local/regional level freestyle snowboard competitions.

Like Me Snowboard Series: Slopestyle and Snowboard Cross

Tabor Mountain Ski Resort will play host to a Slopestyle event on February 1st and a Snowboard Cross event on February 2nd (see schedule below for training and competition days).

- The Like Me Snowboard Series events are totalled for the season using the best two results in each discipline to determine the Overall Series winners in each category
- Athletes at these events are also identified for Development Team, Provincial Team, Canada Winter Games Team
- Like Me Snowboard Series Slopestyle events are awarded Canadian Ranking List points, TTR points and FIS points, and Overall Like Me Snowboard Series points
- Like Me Snowboard Series Snowboard Cross events are awarded Overall Like Me Snowboard Series points and FIS points for the FIS category
- Overall Like Me Snowboard Series points are used to qualify athletes to Nationals
