BC Provincial Snowboard Team Internal Ranking Policy

Approved by the Board of Directors on September 6, 2010

1. Background

The BC Provincial Snowboard Team Ranking Policy is designed to outline team ranking for the athletes selected to the Provincial Freestyle and Snowboard Cross Teams.

2. Policy

BC Snowboard Association ("BCSA") attempts to be fair and equitable in all manner of business. This BC Provincial Snowboard Team Ranking Policy is created to ensure that there is a fair practice of identifying athletes eligible for benefits within the BC Provincial Snowboard Team.

3. Ranking Date

The ranking date used for this Policy shall be the date of the announcement of BC Provincial Snowboard Team Selection (the "Ranking Date").

4. Ranking Process

The athletes within the BC Provincial Snowboard Freestyle and Snowboard Cross Teams will be ranked separately, with an overall ranking and gender ranking within each team.

The most current FIS published list prior to the Ranking Date will be used to allocate each athlete's FIS points portion of the calculation ("FIS Points").

The point scale to allocate points for the Stage of each athlete ("Stage Points") (see BC Snowboard CSC Pacific/PacificSport Carding Criteria and Assignment of Stage Points Policy) is as follows:

Stage 1	100 points
Stage 1A	80 points
Stage 2	60 points
Stage 3	50 points

The Ticket To Ride (TTR) points from the World Snowboard Tour will be used to allocate each athlete's TTR points portion of the calculation for the Freestyle Team ("TTR Points").

The Snowboard Cross ranking will be a combination of an athlete's FIS Points and Stage Points ("Ranking Score").

The Freestyle Team ranking will be a combination of an athlete's FIS points, Stage Points and TTR Points ("Ranking Score").

In the event an athlete does not have FIS points and/or TTR points, he/she will be ranked below the athletes with FIS Points and/or TTR Points in order of his/her selection camp score ("Ranking Score").

The athletes will then be ranked in order of his/her total Ranking Score by gender within the BC Provincial Snowboard Freestyle Team and the BC Provincial Snowboard Cross Team.

5. Tie Breaking

In the event of a tie within the Snowboard Cross Ranking Scores, that tie will be broken by the greater number of FIS Points; and in the event a further tie, that tie will be broken by the best individual score within the FIS Points.

In the event of a tie in the Freestyle Ranking Scores, that tie will be broken by the greater number of points in either the FIS Points or TTR Points of the athletes involved.

6. Eligibility

In order to receive any benefits due to an athlete based on the BC Snowboard Provincial Team Internal Ranking, the athlete must be in good standing with BCSA.
